

# Superlative Adjectives

## Use

Use superlative adjectives to compare more than two people, places, or things.

## Form

### A. Chart

Number of Syllables	Form	Example
<b>one</b>	<i>the + Adj + -est</i>	<i>the + tall + -est = the tallest</i>
<b>two</b> (ending in -y)	<i>the + Adj (-y changes to -i) + -est</i>	<i>the + happy + -est = the happiest</i>
<b>two</b> (not ending in -y)	<i>the + most + Adj</i>	<i>the + most + famous = the most famous</i>
<b>three or more</b>	<i>the + most + Adj</i>	<i>the + most + beautiful = the most beautiful</i>

### B. Examples

1. John is **the tallest** boy in the class.
2. Out of all my classmates, Christina is **the happiest**. She's always smiling!
3. I think Brad Pitt is **the most famous** actor in Hollywood.
4. Her last painting is **the most beautiful** one she's ever done.
