Am I behind you?

No, you aren't behind me, you are in front of

me.

Is the ball behind you now?

No, the ball isn't behind me now, it's on the table in front of me

Is this his pencil?

Yes, it's his pencil.

Is this her book?

Is this house his?

Yes, it's his house.

Is this her ball?

Is this her window?

No, it isn't her window, it's your

window

Is this his cup?

No, it isn't his cup, it's her cup.

Is this my show?

No it isn't your shoe, it's his shoe.

Are the English family standing in front or behind the

house?

No, the English family aren't standing behind the house, they are standing

in front of the house.

Questions (positive)

What am I doing?

You are putting the book on the table.

What are you doing?

I'm sitting on / in the chair.

What is Mr English doing?

Mr English is standing in front of the house.

What are we doing?

We are having an English lesson.

Word Introduction.

Put, Take, Putting, Taking

Positive Questions

What am I doing?

You are taking the book from the

table?

What am I doing now?

You are putting the book on the floor.

What are you doing?

I'm sitting in / on my chair.

What are Mr and Mrs English doing?

Mr and Mrs English are standing in

front of the house.

Questions (negative)

Am I putting the pen on the table?

No, you aren't putting the pen on the table, you are putting the pen in your pocket.

Am I taking the book from the table?

No, you aren't taking the book from the table, you are putting a pen on the floor.

Are you taking the pen from the table?

No, I am not taking the pen from the table, I'm sitting on the chair.

Is Scott English sitting?

No, Scott English isn't sitting, he is standing in front of his house.

Word Introduction

House, Standing, Sitting,

Questions (Positive)

Is Mr English standing in front of his house with his dog?
Yes, Mr English is standing in front of his house with his dog.

Is Mrs English standing with her cat?

Yes, Mrs English is standing with her cat.

Questions (negative)

Is Mr English standing in front of the dog?

No, Mr English isn't standing in front of his dog, he is standing with his dog

Are you standing behind me?

No, I'm not standing behind you, I'm sitting in front of you.

This, That, And,

Questions (positive)

Is this a table?

Yes, it's a table.

Is that a window?

Yes, thats a window.

Is this a dog?

Yes, thats a dog.

Whats that?

It's a cat.

Questions (negative)

Is that a window?

No, that isn't a window, it's a door.

Is that a dog?

No, it isn't a dog, it's a girl.

Where is that dog?

That dog is sitting on the floor.

Where is that pencil?

That pencil is on the floor.

Word Introduction. (Clothing)

Shoe, Boots, Flip Flops, Trousers, Shorts, Suit, Tie, Tee-shirt, Shirt, Blouse, Hat, Jacket,

Questions (positive)

Whats this?

It's a shoe

What colour are these shoes?

Those shoes are black.

What are these?

Those are trousers

What are those?

These are my jeans.

Questions (negaitive)

Are these trousers?

No, they aren't trousers, they are shoes.

Are these trainers?

No, they aren't trainers, they are

boots.

Is this a coat?

No, it isn't a coat, it's a tie.

Is this a shirt?

No, it isn't a shirt, it's a hat.
