Come, Letter,*

The alphabet. (Vowels in bold).

Questions (positive)

Does the letter E come before the letter F?

Yes, the letter E comes before the letter F.

Does the letter P come after the letter M?

Yes, the letter P comes after the letter M.

Does the letter O come between the letters N and P?

Yes, the letter O comes between the letters N and P.

Does the letter F come before or after the letter G?

The letter F comes before the letter G.

Questions (negative)

Does the letter B come after the letter X?

No, the letter B doesn't come after the letter X, it comes before it.

Does the letter U come after the W?

No, the letter U doesn't come after the letter W, it comes before it.

Does the letter J come between the letters M and N?

No, the letter J doesn't come between the letters M and N. The letter J comes between the letters I and K.

Does the letter V come before or after the letter W?

The letter V comes before the letter W.

Word Introduction.

Alphabet, Letter, Noun, Verb, Adjective, Consonant

Explain:

Explain that the letter (a) is a vowel, The letter (b) is a consonant, the word (green) is an adjective, the word (man) is a noun and there are five vowels in the English alphabet.

A, E, I, O, U.

Questions (positive)

What is the first letter of the alphabet?

A's the first letter of the alphabet.

Is Z the last letter of the alphabet?

Yes, Z's the last letter of the alphabet.

Is the word MAN a noun?

Yes, the word MAN is a noun.

Is the word BLUE an adjective?

Yes, the word BLUE is an adjective.

Is the letter B a consonant?

Yes, the letter B is a consonant.

Questions (negative)

Is the letter C a vowel?

No, the letter C isn't a vowel, it's a consonant.

Is the word WALK (Andar) a noun?

No, the word WALK isn't a noun, it's a verb
(verbo)

Is the word WOMAN an adjective?

No, the word WOMAN isn't an adjective, it's a noun.

Are the words CHILD, KID and TABLE verbs?

No, the words CHILD, KID and TABLE aren't
verbs, they are nouns.

Questions Positive

Am I going to the window?

Yes, you are going to the window.

What am I going to do?

You are going to the window.

Am I coming from the door?

Yes, you are coming from the door.

What am I doing?

You are coming from the door.

Is the ceiling high?

Yes, the ceiling is high.

Is the wall high?

Yes, the wall is high.

Is the table low?

Yes, the table is low.

Are all the chairs (Cadeiras) in the room low?

Yes, all the chairs in this room
(Quarto) are low.

Questions (negative)

Am I coming from the window?

No, you aren't coming from the
window, you are coming from the
door.

Am I going to the door?

No, you aren't going to the door, you
are coming from the window.

Are you going to the window?

No, I'm not going to the window, you
are sitting in the chair.

Are you coming from the door?

No, I'm not coming from the door, I'm
sitting in the chair.
