How Many? (Quantos), Are There? (Existem), There Are, (Existem / Hã)

### **Questions (positive)**

How many pencils are there?

There are four pencils.

How many chairs are there?

There are six chairs.

How many books are there on the table?

There are two books on the table.

How many teachers are there is the room?

There is one teacher in the room.

Remind the student that we use the words "ARE" for plural and "IS" for singluar.

How many students are there in this room?

There are (?) students in this room

How many pencils are there on the table?

There are four pencils an the table.

## **Questions (negative)**

Are there three books on the table?

No, there aren't three books on the table, there are two books on the table.

Are there three windows in this room?

No, there aren't three windows in the room, is one window in this room.

Are there twenty students in this room?

No, there aren't twenty students in this room, there is one student in this room.

How many kids are there on the picture?

There are three kids on the picture.

How many cats are there on the picture?

There is one cat on the picture.

Are there five cats on the picture?

No, there aren't five cats on the picture. There is one cat on the picture.

Are there two men on the picture.

No, there aren't two men in the picture. There is one man on the picture.

Are there six women in the picture?

No, there aren't six women in the picture. There is one woman on the picture.

### **Word Introduction**

Is this? (Isto é ), No, it isn't, (Não não é), No, there aren't, (Não há nenhuma), Yes, it is, (Sim é), Yes, there are, (Sim, existem)

# **Questions (positive)**

Is this pencil short?

Yes, this pencil is short.

Is table large?

Yes, this table is large.

Are there two books on the table?

Yes, there are two books on the table

Is this a house?

Yes, it's a house.

Is this a house?

No, it isn't a house, it's a cat.

Are there two pencils on the table or three?

There are two pencils on the table.

## **Questions (negative)**

Are there twenty students in this room?

No, there aren't twenty students in this room. There is one student in this room.

Are there five pencils in this box?

No, there aren't five pencils in this box. There are 2 pencils in this box.

Is there a cat in this room?

No, there isn't a cat in this room.

Is this a box?

No, it isn't a box, it's a table.
