1. I don't have a motorcycle Steve. But, you have two motorcycles.

New idiom:

"A peice of cake" (It is easy) Isso é fácil

Example:

We walked ten (10) miles today. It was a peice of cake.

Caminhamos dez (10) milhas hoje. Foi um pedaço de bolo.

New Expression

"Down in the dumps" (Sentindo-se triste no momento)

"Down in the dumps" means that you are not happy at the moment.

Significa que você não está feliz no momento.

Example:

Today I am feeling down in the dumps. I don't have any money and I want to go to the cinema with my friends.

Hoje estou me sentindo para baixo nas lixeiras. Não tenho dinheiro e quero ir ao cinema com meus amigos.

1. Regular verbs (ed).
2. Irregular verbs (different word).
